


Figure 3: Pretty Lights Episodic Poster / Telluride






Figure 4: 2 Page Atlantic Mag Spread

# Alternative Recourses.

What positive benefits arise from hemp production?



Hemp can be grown on most farmland throughout the U.S., where as forests require large tracts of land available in few locations.



U.S. Presidents and founding fathers George Washington and Thomas Jefferson were hemp advocates.

Hemp was not banned because it was a competitor to cotton. It was banned because it was a competitive threat to the wood products industry and newly developed synthetic fibers that were patentable.



**SUBSTITUTE**  
Hemp can replace cotton and can be used to make all types of clothing.



**BUILDING MATERIALS**  
Wood-like building materials can be derived from hemp and are stronger and cheaper than wood.



**FUEL**  
Hemp produces biomass that can be converted to fuel in a process called pyrolysis, producing ethanol or bio-sulphur man-made coal.



**NUTRITION**  
The hemp plant can be processed to produce tofu, protein powder, oil, and other foods.



**LESS POLLUTION**  
Fewer caustic and toxic chemicals are used to make paper from hemp than are used to make paper from trees.



**FEWER PESTICIDES**  
50% of all pesticides used in the U.S. are used on cotton. Hemp naturally repels weed growth and has few insect enemies.



**MEDICINAL**  
Hemp's sister plant can be processed to provide numerous medicinal alternatives for patients in need.



**RENEWABLE**  
Most hemp-derived products are nontoxic, biodegradable, and renewable.




Figure 7: Old Time Radio Animation
