


Figure 1: DimensionX\_1.




Figure 3: DimensionX\_3.




Figure 4: DimensionX\_4.






Figure 9: Laser Poster\_1.




Figure 10: Laser Poster\_2.




Figure 11: Matthew Shepard Foundation.




Figure 12: Maxam Website.






Figure 18: The Entire Northern Side.






Figure 20: Water Center\_Logo.
